Launch of the 2nd Edition of the POR-Mitacs Fellowships: Supporting the Integration of Patient-Oriented Approaches in the Workplace

Quebec, November 13, 2024 – PASSERELLE, the National Training Entity for the Patient-Oriented Research (POR) Strategy, in collaboration with Mitacs, is pleased to announce the launch of the second edition of the POR-Mitacs Fellowships. This unique program is designed for students and postdoctoral fellows from all disciplines and aims to support research projects that integrate the principles of patientoriented research (POR), while providing opportunities for training, networking, and mentorship.

A Fellowship of up to \$50,000 for Innovative Projects

The fellowships, valued at up to \$50,000, follow the same funding model as the Mitacs Acceleration Fellowships and include an equal contribution from the selected partner organization and Mitacs. Additionally, PASSERELLE offers compensation of up to \$5,000 to support fellowship recipients' participation in capacity-building activities such as training, events, or patient and public engagement activities.

A One-Year Program to Develop Skills in Patient-Oriented Research

The program will run from June 2025 to May 2026, offering fellows professional development activities, networking opportunities, and personalized mentorship. Fellows will complete a minimum six-month placement with a partner organization (company, non-profit organization, hospital, or municipality) to acquire new skills and expand their professional network.

Who Can Apply?

Applications are open to full-time undergraduate, college and graduate students, and postdoctoral fellows from eligible Canadian universities who are interested in patient-oriented research. Applicants must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents, or international students over 18 years of age. The application deadline is **February 7, 2025.**



An Opportunity to Contribute to Improving Healthcare

This program offers a unique opportunity to contribute to improving healthcare, social, and community services, as well as patient well-being, by promoting the integration of patient voices and experiences into the research process. Fellows will also be integrated into the PASSERELLE community, gaining access to exclusive resources, discussion forums, and a network of peers and mentors.

How to Apply?

Interested candidates must follow these steps to submit their application:
